Capable of subtle variations in appearance and strength, a close match with almost any stone

can be achieved. Where a carved or moulded item is repeated and costs are crucial, Codestone provides the perfect alternative to natural stone.

With an experienced team of designers, draughtsmen and carvers, a project can be taken from an initial idea to the finished item. Past commissions have ranged from balustrading and urns, to sculpture and the reproduction of an elaborately carved fountain from Versailles.

TIMBER PRESERVATION

The preservation of timber buildings, with the elimination of rot and beetle infestation, is one of the services provided. Repair or replacement of original timberwork is carried out by specialist carpenters, with carvers adding the fine detail.

SPECIALISED JOINERY

Combining traditional skills with the production facilities of modern fully equipped workshops, Rattee and Kett produce high quality structural, decorative and functional joinery.

BRICKWORK

CARVING


