

Accidents which happened to Frederick William Paige
who was 30 years a servant of the Great Eastern
Railway Co.

Right arm broken

Ruptured a blood vessel

Right leg fractured and bone protruded
through the skin

Right ribs badly injured and one broken

Right eye taken out and scraped

Fifth finger of right hand dislocated

Second finger nail and part of first joint
of right hand taken away

Left side badly injured and cartilages ruptured
nearly fatal

Left arm nearly torn out by an engine

Left arm dislocated

Right leg badly injured two years before
he recovered

Left hand poisoned dangerously

He had had several teeth extracted, also
had been leeches, bled, cupped, blistered,
and had mustard plasters by dozens.

He died by sudden inflammation in
the heart on Sept. 18 1874.
