6. House Pictures: Each house, with information about occupier from Street Directory (Head of Household or 'Garden'), or first recorded Census.



Despite the date '1901', the 'Terrace' was built over a 20 year period, starting with No 24 & 26 (1881-1884), and concluding with No 14 (1904-1910).

'Pretoria Terrace' celebrates British victories during the Boer War in South Africa.

With Fern Cottages it is one of only two group of houses in the road given a distinctive name, and is a reminder that the British Empire was very much a reality for the early residents of Hemingford Road.

The terrace was built on Building Lots 18 & 19 of the 1878 sale by the Johnson family.

Ned Pamphilon, Builder, of 59 Gwydir St, probably bought both Lots in the original sale – he is recorded as owner of Lot 18 in 1878 (D: Hemingford Ho), and owned both Lots by 1897 (SI).

No 14 had been sold to the occupier, John Curtis, by 1910 (Land Valuation). The other properties remained tenanted until sold by the Pamphilon family in 1935. At that date the tenants were all long standing, and on weekly tenancies:
